

A general checklist of items to bring to your first appointment:

- Current health insurance and prescription card
- A list of your doctors and their telephone numbers
- A list of current medications and dosages

Note: At the request of our clinic staff, you may be asked to bring the following items to your first appointment. You do not need to bring your M. D. Anderson records.

- Pathology slides
- Radiation oncology records
- Copies of doctors' notes and operative reports
- Diagnostic film, such as CT scans, ultrasounds, and/or X-rays (These items must be hand-carried to your first appointment. Please do not mail **unless** requested by your referral specialist.)
